

Welcome to the 5th Annual Frederick County Goes Purple (FCGP)

Last year all 12 Frederick County Municipalities with many city and county buildings were decorated; 7 municipalities had memorial banners displaying lost loved ones up for a week; All 22 Frederick County Middle and High Schools participated; Many businesses, churches and nonprofits "went purple"; Thousands of shirts, lanyards and bracelets were worn; Thousands of postcards were handed out; Over 70+ large banners went up all around the county; "Purple Certified" trainings were held at many businesses, Frederick County Public High Schools and the Frederick Government.

What is FCGP? A grassroots call to action to unify our Frederick County community to reduce substance-related deaths and overdoses. This massive community-wide observance takes place during *National Recovery Month in September* with ongoing training throughout the year, demonstrating that Frederick County supports those in active addiction, recovery, and their loved ones; offers hope and resources; and invests in youth through prevention education.

Why? The death rate from substance abuse continues to worsen. These are our sons and daughters. "National Recovery Month" in September is associated with the color purple. The entire community is encouraged to "go purple" by obtaining training, bringing awareness and understanding of substance abuse disorders, celebrating those living in recovery, and honoring First Responders.

How Can One Participate? There are three ways for individuals, families, community-based organizations, schools and businesses to get involved: This is a Crossed Bridges initiative (www.crossedbridges.com).

- First, most importantly, schedule "Purple Certified" training for your company or organization.
- Second, thank First Responders, decorate, display banners, distribute postcards, obtain merchandise, promote FCGP messages on your social media, and sponsor memorial t-shirt and banner purchases.
- Third, sign up on The Bridge to learn about and help with real-time local needs from Frederick County organizations working with those in crisis throughout the year.

"In The Street's" t-shirt give away in downtown Frederick, September 9 @Market St. Social media updates throughout the month.
